Upgrading the Water Supply Network to Mweiga Town and the adjacent areas.

The upgrade exercise of the Mweiga - Kihuyo corridor supply network which has been ongoing in phases is still continuing. The technical team has been working on the section between Sasini Estate and Ikumari junction in the month of March. The objective of the upgrade is to increase the volume of water supply to customers in Mweiga and the adjacent areas which has been informed by an increase in demand. The upgrade has also been necessitated by the regular pipe bursts experienced in this section as a result of the poor state of the PVC pipes. The exercise involves replacement of old dilapidated PVC pipes with larger High density polyethylene (HDPE) pipes. This will kill two birds with one stone in that apart from increasing the volume of water to customers, it will also decrease the amount of water lost through pipe bursts and leakages also known as non- revenue water. Customers in Kihuyo, Njeng'u, Ikumari, Mweiga, Kamatongu and Mwireri expected to notice a considerable improvement in supply as soon as the upgrade of the whole section is completed. The works are projected to be complete by the end of April 2021. The company is committed to improving the customer experience in all its services.










King'ong'o Pumping Station

Debunking the Sewer Myth

The King'ong'o Sewer Pumping Station was commissioned in October 2019 and it has been operating smoothly. Contrary to the common belief that associates Sewer with filthy environments, the Pumping Station is nothing but picturesque. From the neatly manicured lawns, to the welldesigned plant, you would be forgiven to think that you are in a five-star hotel. The company is tackling Sanitation issues in its area of operations hands on. Customers from Gatende/ Garden Estate, Nyeri Inn and the surrounding areas are the main beneficiaries of the pumping station. The station acts as a collection point for waste water which is screened and then pumped to the company's main waste water treatment plant in Kangemi. Here, the sewer water undergoes a treatment process which converts it into effluent which is returned to the water cycle with acceptable impact on the environment. The effluent is regularly monitored through tests which are performed in ISO/IEC17025:2017 accredited Laboratory. Nyeri Water and Sanitation has a laboratory which serves as a NEMA reference lab in the region. The company is committed to environmental conservation and encourages re- use of the treated waste water.


