4. DESIGNATED EFFLUENT DISCHARGE POINT

Discharge will ONLY be permitted in NYEWASCO's Kangemi or Kiganjo Waste Water Treatment Plants or any other designated discharge points. Should ensure that there is no spillage of effluent outside the designated area.

CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT

1. No person shall discharge or apply any poisonous, toxic, noxious or obstructing matter, radioactive waste or other pollutants or permit any person to dump or discharge such matter into NYEWASCO sewer unless the discharge of such poisonous, toxic, noxious or obstructing matter, radioactive waste or pollutant is treated to permissible standards as set out in the Fifth Schedule of the Environmental Management and Co-ordination (Water Quality) Regulations, 2006.
2. In the event of a complaint in the quality, the laboratory services unit shall collect random effluent samples to confirm the concentration/ composition of the sewage with or without notice.
3. You shall provide NYEWASCO with a certificate of registration by National Environment Management Authority (NEMA).
4. The exhauster vehicle shall be inspected by NYEWASCO at the headquarters before issuance of permit.
5. The exhauster vehicle shall always remain fitted with a sealed tank and accessories that are leak proof to liquid and gases, a pump capable of drawing viscous sludge and print capacity on the rear, right and left sides of the tank
6. You shall exhaust domestic wastewater only and not industrial effluent and discharge only at the designated points by NYEWASCO
7. You shall make monthly returns and avail the same as required by the company at time of renewal of the permit. The returns shall include the number of loads exhausted and the sources.
8. That you shall pay monthly sewage discharge fees of Kshs. 15,000 per truck.
9. You shall strictly observe and comply with the legal provisions related to sewage handling operations which include but are not limited to:
 - a) Water Act, 2016
 - b) The Water (Services Regulatory) Rules, 2012.
 - c) Environmental Management and Co-ordination (Water Quality) Regulations, 2006.
 - d) The Water Resources Management Rules, 2012.
 - e) The Environmental Management and Coordination Act ,1999
 - f) Environmental Management and Co-ordination (Water Quality) Regulations, 2006 g)
The Public Health Act
 - h) Local Government Act
 - i) Nyeri Municipal Council By-laws
 - j) The NYEWASCO Dischargers Effluent Quality Policy and Procedures
 - k) NYEWASCO Sanitation Procedure
 - l) Any other written laws
10. You shall display in your truck the originals of the letter of Approval to discharge into the sewerage system, payment receipt of the discharge fee and the Business permit issued by Nyeri County Government.

11. NYEWASCO RESERVES THE RIGHT to take any appropriate legal action including cancellation of the permit in the event that you fail to comply with above laid down conditions.

12. Penalties

- a) Violations of the conditions by the Applicant will lead to imposition of a penalty.
- b) First offenders will be issued with an improvement order and required to submit an action plan for the corrective action within 24 hours for approval by CMTS prior to implementation.
- c) In the event that the discharge of the substandard waste water continues unabated, a fine not exceeding Kshs. 500,000 (Five Hundred Thousand only) will be imposed on the defaulter and also required to comply with the quality standards.
- d) The Company may take appropriate actions to recover the cost of restoration of its sewerage system back to its normal state.
- e) Failure to comply with the effluent quality standard repeatedly will lead to revocation of permit.
- f) Discharging at undesignated points will result to cancellation of the operators permit and attract a penalty of Kshs. 100,000/- (One Hundred Thousand only)
